HOW TO SUBMIT OBJECTIONS

Written objections to the renewal of the license or in support of suspension of the license based on the operation of the licensed premises can be submitted by any interested party to the Office of the City Clerk-License Division, City Hall, Room 105, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, WI, 53202, or via email to license@milwaukee.gov.

WHEN TO SUBMIT OBJECTIONS

Written objections to the renewal of the license or in support of suspension of the license must be received 45 days before the expiration of the current license.

WHAT TO SUBMIT IN OBJECTIONS

Written objections must include the following information:

1. Name of the person objecting.
2. Mailing or email address of the person objecting.
3. Information known to the objector that may form a basis for nonrenewal or suspension of the license. Such information should relate to the manner in which the operation of the license premises during the current license period has had an adverse impact on the health, safety and welfare of the public and the neighborhood.

Notice to Applicants: Upon filing of the application, this notice shall be posted in a conspicuous place viewable to members of the public from the outside of the licensed premises, and shall remain posted until 45 days before the expiration of the current license. WHY POST NOTICE

Effective July 1, 2010, all renewal applicants for alcohol beverage retail establishment licenses are required to post a Notice of Public Interest (form ccl-not4) for the purposes of providing notice to the public that a renewal application has been filed and that written objections to the renewal of the license or support of suspension of the license based on the operation of the licensed premises can be submitted by any interested party to the Office of the City Clerk-License Division. WHERE TO POST NOTICE

The Notice of Public Interest is required to be posted in a conspicuous place viewable to members of the public from the outside of the licensed premises. The posting and maintaining of the notice shall be at the expense of the applicant.

WHEN, HOW LONG TO POST NOTICE

The Notice of Public Interest is required to be posted upon filing of the renewal application with the Office of the City Clerk-License Division, and shall remain posted until 45 days before the expiration of the current license. See expiration date printed on current license for assistance in determining date after which notice is no longer required to be posted.
