



Jail & Huber Utilization Committee Minutes:

Monday, August 15th, 2016 – 8:00am

- i.) **Complex Case Study** – Tom provided the group with a de-identified case with complex issues. The group talked through the different challenges and ways hand off and coordination could improve for inmates upon release.
- ii.) **Municipal Commitments** – The House of Correction provided a snapshot list of individuals who are currently at the House of Correction serving municipal commitments. Based on the list provided, most commitments were issued/enforced by the City of West Allis. It was also noted that West Allis’s fines seem much higher than most other area citations. Legal Aid Society is currently discussing if a project to evaluate indigence for individuals booked on commitments.
- iii.) **Treatment to Competency Updates** – statewide waits for transport to treatment are currently around 90 days. Statewide, there are currently 72 individuals awaiting transport to treatment, 23 of which are from Milwaukee. During the month of July, there were 33 admissions to treatment (statewide), 18 of which are from Milwaukee. In the coming weeks, Mendota will be opening 14 additional beds.
- iv.) **Jail/HOC/MSDF Trend and Population Updates** –the jail noted that the population of the jail is currently at 918 and has been managed with the support of the staff at the House of Correction. It was noted that weekends have been busier than before and counts are up about 100 inmates over last year. The HOC is currently housing around 500 pretrial inmates. MSDF noted that around 300 of their inmates are in on DAI, the remaining 700 are in for mixed reasons. Ron Malone is willing to provide a more detailed breakdown at a future meeting.
- v.) **Other Business/Updates** – Ron noted that he will be attending a statewide training for wardens this week on trauma informed care.
