iii.) MacArthur Foundation Safety + Justice Challenge Update – a number of CJC members continue to work on the SJC Phase 1 project. Data from multiple agencies has been compiled and is currently be evaluated to determine areas where Milwaukee can more effectively use the jail, meaning incarcerating those who need to be and releasing those who can safely reside in the community. The Foundation is also requesting that Milwaukee show a commitment and plan to address racial and ethnic disparities within the CJ system in order to qualify for Phase 2 funding (up to \$2MM/year for a minimum of two years).

- Committee discussed ideas on how to better determine who/how many people with mental health issues are in the jail/HOC? Is there a data-driven way to review disparities? How are we collecting race/ethnicity?
